This month I taught 1 PEP class and 1 Sr PEP class, total attendance was 22 people.

I met with Deborah at LAH Town Hall to discuss various CERT programs and planning for the LAH Town Staff drill on 10/21/11. I taught this drill to the LAH Staff and Council members on their roles in a disaster. This was a 2-hour drill, which also included information from the San Bruno fire of last year.

I taught a basic disaster preparedness class to a Brownie troop from Los Altos when they told them they could not provide this service to anyone in Los Altos. 12 Brownies attend along with several parents.

I spent a large amount of time this month preparing for the LAH Town drill as well as the LAHCFD CERT drill on 10/22/11. The drill on 10/22/11 for our CERT members had 33 CERT's attend, they set up the ARK, performed light search and rescue, fire extinguishers, area survey of Foothill College and performed several other tasks along the way.

I did two neighborhood network programs this month. 1 at Rudolph-Snyder home 26450 Aric Ln LAH and 1 at the Pfefelere's home 870 Terrace Dr Los Altos area. Both had good attendance and really liked what services we provide to our citizens.

I met with Patrick from the Purissima Water District, we discussed possibly placing an container on the Toyon Water Yard, corner of El Monte & Moody Rd to be used for storage of Town required material that is issued by the Santa Clara County OES dept., we would also store small animal supplies such as dog and cat crates, food and water dishes inside.

I met with an electrician to have more plugs installed in the ARK
