R14 responded on an outside smoke investigation. The RP was contacted at 27390 Deer Springs Way who then pointed across canyon (west) toward what looked like smoke. The smoke was determined to be coming from the Hidden Villa Campground. This was significant due to the fact that down canyon winds had dispersed the campfire smoke and it could be detected all the way down Moody to the station, resulting in numerous calls.

Aside from the above incidents, E314 patrolled the Los Altos Hills as usual. A new gate was discovered at the top of Sherlock Rd. It was unlocked and not an access issue.

Debris was found at the end of Country. It was brush and construction debris. The debris had been removed by July 1 and no longer posed an access problem.

E314 crews took part in a 3 day County Wide Wildland Training Exercise, along with the Dept.'s 4 other Type 3 Engines.

It was also noted that Central was being paved and improvements being made.
