

**June 2015 Monthly Report

**This month I attended the LAH Town Picnic where we had 16 LAHCFD CERT members assist me in running the booth which consisted of the Disaster Trailer, table top display items, zone map and fire safety wheel. We had over 100 people stop and get information on disaster preparedness.**

**I attended the Emergency Volunteer Center training offered in Morgan Hill. This was a 5-hour class on dealing with citizen volunteers and what to expect as well as how to organize them in a time of emergency. I will be teaching a condensed version of this EVC training to our LAHCFD CERT team in July.**

**I have started researching the item requested on dealing with minors found during a disaster and what to do with them once we have located them. I am designing a program for our CERT members that will require them to have obtained ICS 100, 200 and 700 prior to being finger printed with a background check. The finger printing will be done by the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office for a cost of about \$23 per person. I anticipate that we will have around 20 CERT individuals being at this level. I will also be doing a short training session in September for our entire CERT team on the minors program as well as additional training for the 20 or so finger printed CERT members.**

**We held our continuing training for LAHCFD CERT members on June 16<sup>th</sup> at Town Hall. The topic was CERT procedures when working around utility-related emergencies, presented by PG&E representative Dane Lobb. This was a very well attended program with over 70 CERT members in attendance.**

**I also attended the semi monthly meeting at headquarters for all Emergency Service Coordinators.**
