

User Overview (January 1, 2020 – March 14, 2021)

- Users users who have initiated at least 1 session during date range
- New users number of first-time users during selected date range
- Sessions the period of time a user is actively engaged with website
- Pageviews total number of pages viewed (repeated views of a single page are counted)
- Bounce Rate the percentage of single-page sessions in which there was no interaction with the page.
 A bounce rate has a session duration of 0 seconds.
