August 17, 2021

NEW HEALTH ORDER

- All individuals, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a mask when indoors in public settings, with limited exceptions
- Effective 8/3/2021
- Businesses are required to implement the indoor face covering order and are encouraged to make face coverings available to individuals entering their business

Face coverings are not required when:

- in one's own residence or with members of their household
- working in a closed room or office alone
- actively performing an activity that cannot be done while wearing a face covering (e.g., actively eating or drinking, swimming or showering in a fitness facility, or obtaining a medical or cosmetic service requiring removal of a face covering)

79.9% 12 and older who completed vaccination *

268** new cases (7-Day Rolling Average) ^

* Completed vaccination is the number of county residents who either received a vaccine requiring a single dose or received the final dose of a vaccine requiring multiple doses.

** Due to data transmission issues between Kaiser and the state's CalREDIE system since early July, case and testing data are currently under reported

^ The 7-day rolling average of new cases is the average number of new cases each day in the past 7 days, excluding the most recent 7 days
