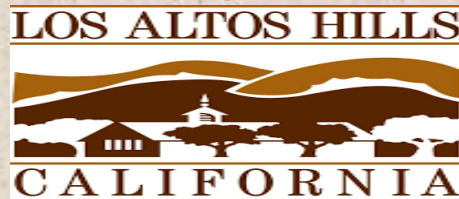

Scope of Work- 3.5 mile of roadside treatment

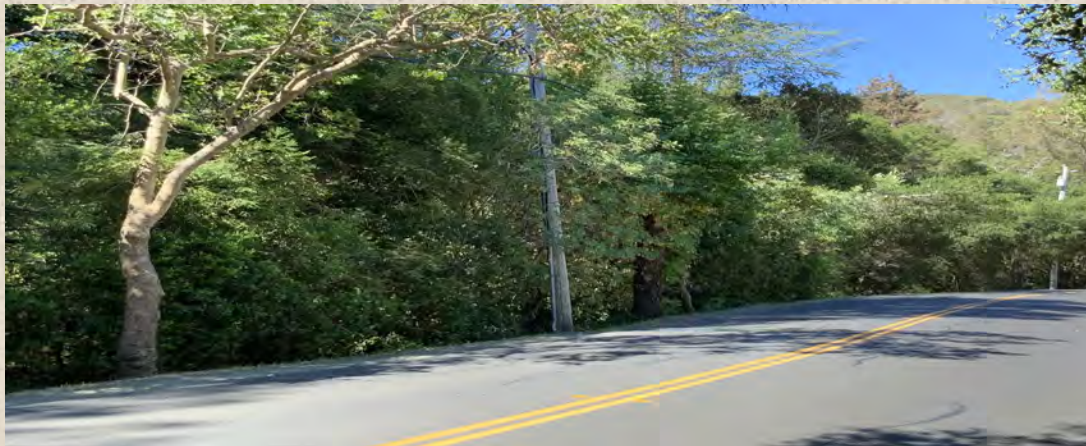
