COVID-19 VACCINATIONS FOR KIDS (AGES 5-11)

Everyone ages 5 and up is now eligible for a free COVID-19 vaccine!

The CDC recommends that children ages 5-11 receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA URGES BOOSTERS AHEAD OF HOLIDAYS

County of Santa Clara Public Health Department recommends all eligible members of the public who live or work in the County receive a COVID-19 booster shot.

The booster is appropriate for almost everyone ages 18 and older, 6-months following the last Pfizer or Moderna vaccination, or 2-months following the Johnson & Johnson vaccination.

The State of California recently informed local health jurisdictions and providers to allow patients to self-determine their risk of exposure and to not turn a patient away who is requesting a booster:

We expect that data will be made available by the week of November 15th and it will be included on this dashboard shortly thereafter, once it has been validated locally.

** The 7-day rolling average of new cases is the average number of new cases each day in the past 7 days, excluding the most recent 7 days
