Background:

The District is engaged in a public process to gather input and discuss District goals and objectives for the next two years. A series of meetings have occurred since early August facilitating discussion at a local and regional level. Through this process clear challenges have emerged of a region with unique vulnerabilities due to its proximity to large areas of open space and limited routes for evacuation, as well as patterns of more extreme and unpredictable weather threats.

Efforts to tackle these challenges regionally by sharing resources and finding creative ways to make the most of assets and funds must be factored into the strategies for work going forward. Further, the District is in a position to provide support for defensible mitigation efforts against wildfire, such as the CZU Complex. In so doing the District can supplement and reinforce efforts by the County, and make the northern border of Santa Clara County better prepared to withstand natural disasters.

Revised Narrative and Goals & Objectives for Commission Consideration

It is important the description of the District's challenges and goals for the next two years reflect the vision of the Commission and the community. The purpose of the review and discussion at tonight's meeting is to confirm the Commission's consensus with the description of past achievements, an assessment of factors influencing the District, both negative and positive, and the goals and objectives for the next two years to drive work and resource allocation.
