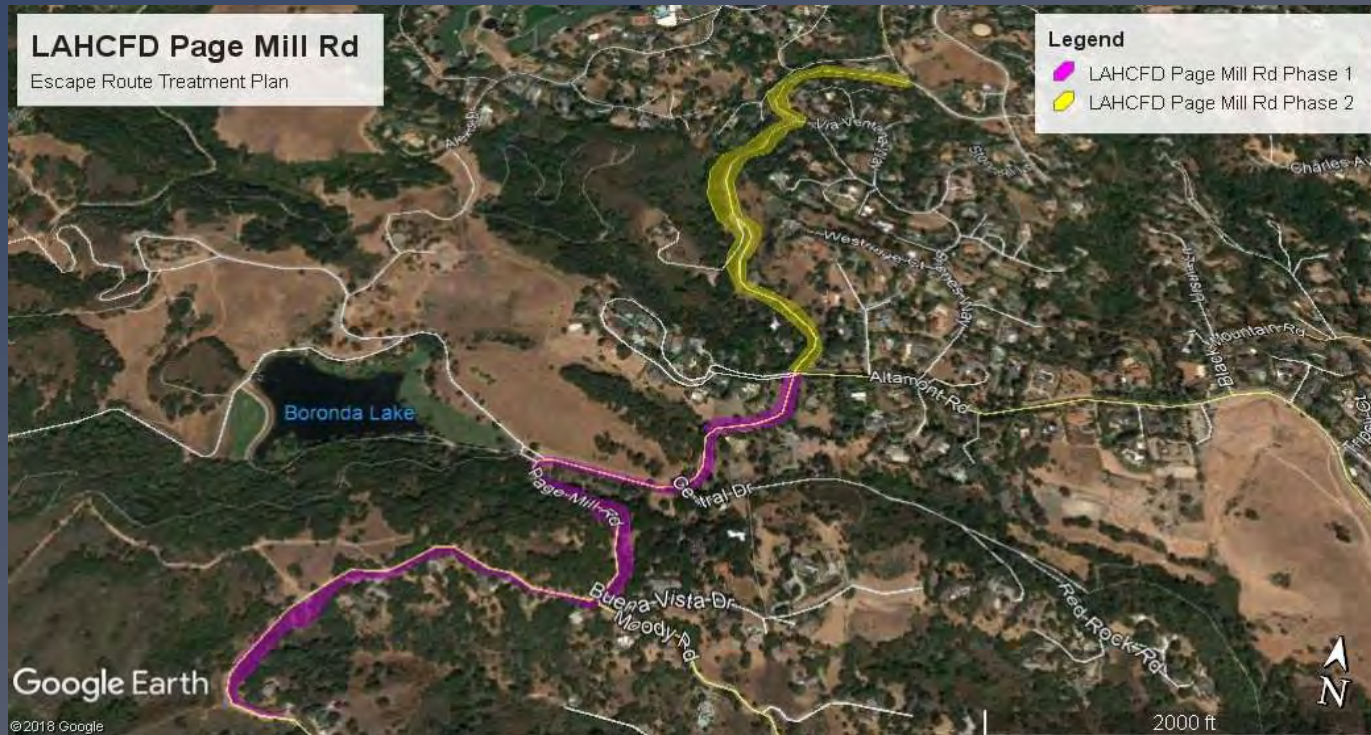

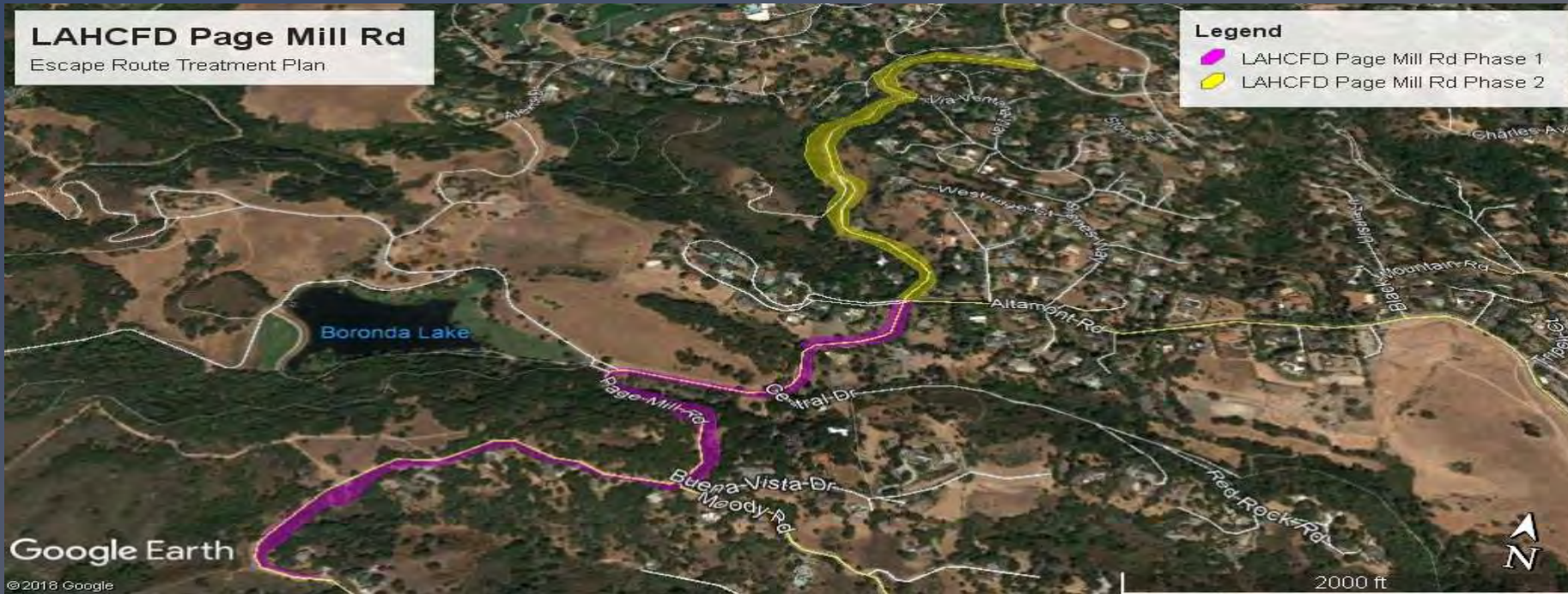
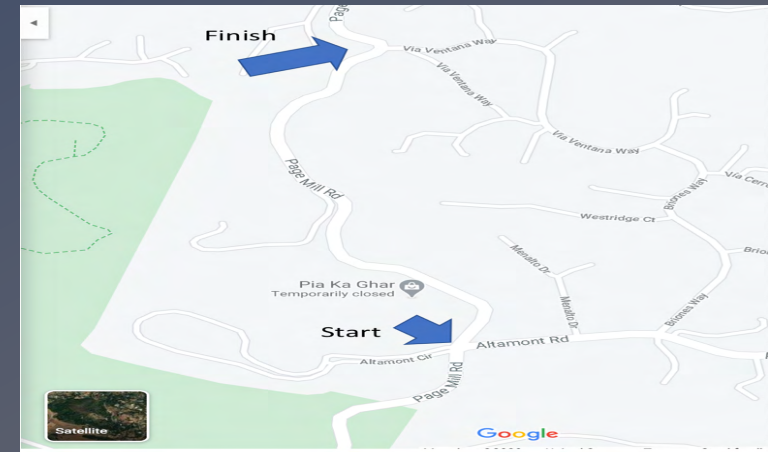

## COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) ACTIVITIES & UPDATES

### Revitalization of the ARK Emergency Hub

- All bins have been inventoried and relabeled and weight tested
- Need new map of set-up ( Commissioner Kearney helping )
- Decision was made to reorganize the bin system at the Ark to better reflect where to start when showing up at the Ark using a color-coding system integrated with assignments to assist IC.
- We have ordered 5 WPV Ready-bags and will be organizing and stocking them for the ARK & trailers

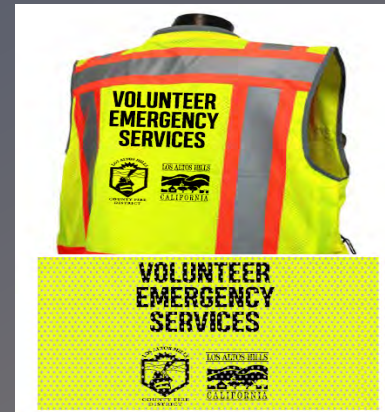


### CERT Trailers:

## COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) ACTIVITIES & UPDATES

### Training & Activities:

- CERT Meeting schedule remains: 2 trainings & 2 meetings a month
  - A CERT General meeting is held monthly as well as a monthly CERT Supervisor meeting
  - What began as a 3-part Recon series..... has taken a life of its own!
  - A Recon team of about 17 volunteers has been established with bi-monthly trainings
  - Volunteers are planning a table-top drill by Zoom in the coming month
  - Next steps after the Recon table-top drill will be trainings on radio language and use
